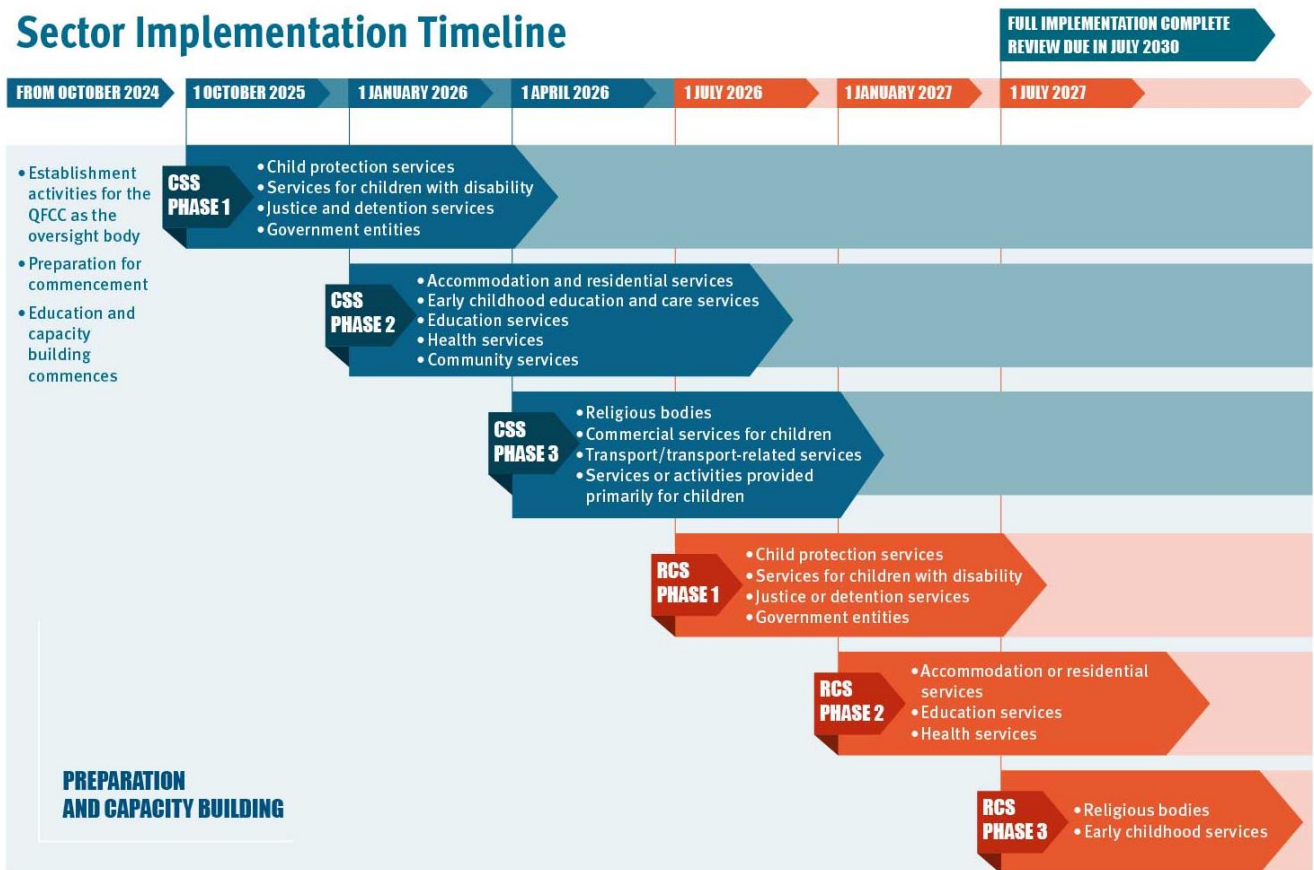
Child Safe Organisations

Different sectors will be required to implement the Child Safe Standards and the Reportable Conduct Scheme at different stages. The following information summarises the sectors and their timeframes so child safe entities (organisations) can work towards becoming compliant with the 10 Child Safe Standards and Universal Principle. Not all child safe entities are required to implement the Reportable Conduct Scheme.

The Queensland Family and Child Commission is the oversight body that will implement, monitor and report on the operation of the Child Safe Organisations system. We are engaging with sectors, building the team and prepare resources. Organisations will meet their obligations by self-assessing their level of readiness and making an action plan to ensure policies, procedures and practices are designed to prevent harm to children. Together we will build a culture of safety and wellbeing for all Queensland children.

Detailed information about who is considered a child safe entity can be found in Schedule 1 of the [Child Safe Organisations Act 2024](#). Schedule 2 of the Act provides details on the reporting entities that will be required to implement the Reportable Conduct Scheme. If your organisation is a reporting entity, you are also considered a child safe entity.
